Trichloroethylene (TCE) groundwater plume: Next Steps

PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting is to develop a forward-looking timeline for addressing the trajectory of the TCE plume relative to the Cedar River Well Field, based on (1) the most recent plume migration information, (2) the findings from the preliminary engineering study for installing a new well field, and (3) the State of Michigan's anticipated appropriations process. We will also introduce possible options and next steps for addressing residual TCE in the groundwater.
